- Employer-employee data (1974-2020)
- Retiree data (1995-2020)
- Freelancer professionals (2000-2017) and collaborators (2000-2019) data
- Social security contribution histories for a sample of 13% of all individuals born after 1950 (available up to 2020)
- Income support beneficiaries' data (up to 2018)
- Balance sheet data (from CERVED; 1996-2018)
- Domestic workers' (2000-2017), farmers and sharecroppers' (2000-2016) data
- Firm level employment and wage data (2005-2020)
- Maternity leave and parental leave claims (2000-2020)
- Public workers data (in progress)
