Titolo presentazione: Intended and unintended effects of pension reforms: employment response, program substitution, health and equity concerns among older workers

Sintesi:

Italy has experienced a substantial increase in life expectancy during the last decades, but this desirable societal achievement has challenged pension systems sustainability. Policy makers have responded to this demographic pressure by restricting access to retirement and increasing statutory pension age. This project aims at exploring some unintended effects of work life extension, namely health consequences of prolonging exposure to work, increased welfare dependency and program substitution, and, finally, equity concerns implied by socio-economic differences in health and life expectancy.
