INPS DATABASES AVAILABLE FOR VISITINPS SCHOLARS

The following databases are currently available to VisitINPS fellows (new datasets may be forthcoming, or there may be updates to the datasets' time range).

- Workers and social security beneficiaries' demographics database (birth date and municipality, year of entry labour market, retirement year...).
- Firms demographics database (firm birth date and municipality, sector...)
- Employer-employee database in the private sector (annual level, from 1974 to 2024)
- Employer-employee database in the private sector (monthly level from 2005 to 2024)
- Notional earnings database for events of temporary unemployment or sick-leave (monthly level from 2005 to 2024)
- Pensions database (from 1995 to 2023)
- Professionals database (from 2000 to 2022)
- Contractors (from 2000 to 2019)
- Sample of 13% of social security contribution histories for individuals born after the 1950 (available up to 2023)
- Recipients of income support benefits (available up to 2023)
- Database on job contracts variations (hirings, firings, extension, conversion), containing information like education, occupation (5-digit ISCO) and date of the variation (from 2008 to 2024)
- Firms' balance sheet data (source CERVED from 1996 to 2018)
- Domestic workers (from 2000 to 2023)
- Agricultural Employees and farmers (from 2000 to 2023)
- Firm level employment and wage data (from 2005 to 2024)
- Data on maternity leave requests (from 2000 to 2022)
- Data on parental leave requests (from 2000 to 2022)
- Public sector workforce data (monthly level, from 2014 to 2023)

Any linkage with individual-level databases from external sources will be evaluated on a case-by-case basis in compliance with privacy regulations and there might be allowed only if accordance of the Visiting Program's rules. Any query for INPS internal data not yet included in the VisitINPS platform would be considered on a case-by-case basis, considering the availability of the internal structures involved and if they meet visiting program's rules.
