

INPS DATABASES AVAILABLE TO VISITINPS SCHOLARS

The following databases are currently available to VisitINPS fellows. New datasets may become available, and existing datasets may be updated to extend their time coverage.

- Workers' and social security beneficiaries' demographic database, including date and municipality of birth, year of labour-market entry, retirement year, and related information.
- Firms' demographic database, including firm date of establishment, municipality, sector, and related information.
- Employer-employee database in the private sector (annual level, from 1974 to 2025)
- Employer-employee database for the private sector, monthly level, from 2005 to 2025.
- Notional earnings database for periods of temporary unemployment or sick leave, monthly level, from 2005 to 2025.
- Pensions database (from 1995 to 2025)
- Professionals database (from 2000 to 2024)
- Parasubordinate workers (contractors, from 2000 to 2025)
- Sample covering 13% of social security contribution histories ("Estratti conto") for individuals born after 1950, available up to 2023.
- Recipients of income support benefits (available up to 2025)
- Database on changes in job contracts, including hirings, dismissals, extensions, and conversions, with information such as education, occupation according to the 5-digit ISCO classification, and date of the change, from 2008 to 2025.
- Firms' balance sheet data (source CERVED from 1996 to 2018, ORBIS from 1999 to 2024)
- Domestic workers (from 2000 to 2025)
- Agricultural employees and farmers, from 2000 to 2023.
- Firm-level employment and wage data, from 2005 to 2025.
- Data on maternity leave requests (from 2000 to 2025)
- Data on parental leave requests (from 2000 to 2025)
- Public sector workforce data (monthly level, from 2014 to 2025)

Any linkage with individual-level databases from external sources will be evaluated on a case-by-case basis, in compliance with privacy regulations, and may be allowed only if consistent with the rules of the Visiting Program. Any request for INPS internal data not yet included in the VisitINPS platform will be considered on a case-by-case basis, taking into account the availability of the internal structures involved and whether the request complies with the rules of the Visiting Program.
