Taking 2018 programme of activities into account, the three Components are implementing 38 topics, more specifically, C1: 17, C2: 10, C3: 11. Of these 38 topics, 28 have inter-component interactions, 10 have no immediately visible interaction. Two C1 topics interact with two C2 topics. One C2 topic interacts with two topics of C1 and one of C3; other 3 topics of C2 interact with two topics of C1, and one C2 topic with two topics of C3. Therefore, the 12 interactive topics of C1 have 15 interactions, and the 10 interactive topics of C2 have 15 interactions, while in the case of C3 the number of interactions is equal to the number of topics. In conclusion, there are 19 interactions among 28 interactive topics.

Between 2015 and 2017 both inclusive, 27 short term Chinese experts and 35 European experts produced technical reports for the project. For C1, it was 15 Chinese and 13 EU short term experts; for each of C2 and C3, 9 Chinese and 14 EU. 2 Chinese and 2 EU experts produced reports for both C1 and C2, 1 Chinese and 1 EU for both C1 and C3, 3 EU for both C2 and C3 and 1 EU for each of the three components. This expertise-sharing contributes to the overall coherence of project findings and recommendations.
